The homestead exemption reduces the taxable value of your home provided:

- The home is occupied by the homeowner on January 1, *and* the homeowner applies for the homestead exemption in the county in which the property is located.

The deadline to file the exemption in most Georgia counties is March 1, 2013.

A homestead exemption is important for you as it may mean you will pay less tax on your property, however:

- You are not exempt from school taxes levied by municipalities.
- You are not exempt from paying interest on and retiring bond debts.

To be granted homestead exemption, you must file an application with the tax commissioner's office in your county. In some counties the tax assessor's office has been designated to receive applications for the homestead exemption.

Please check with your county regarding specific procedures and deadlines before going to file your exemption.
